



British Army in Ireland, June 1904




Army Facilities in Dublin, June 1904





Militia and Yeomanry in Ireland, 1904








Location of Mount Jerome Cemetery




Location of College Street DMP Station





Location of Aldborough House, North Dublin



Location of River Dodder Accommodation Walk





Anglo-Zulu War, South Africa, 1879


























